

## House Bill 487 Substitute Bill Description

		<b>Amendments</b>
		Provide that when a district participates in an expedited program and becomes eligible for the Classroom Facilities Assistance Program that if the districts tangible personal property makes up more than 18% of the personal property valuation the district share will be the lesser of 1) the percentage locked in when expedited agreement was signed or 2) the % using the current wealth percentile rank.
		Exclude specified Community Based Correctional Facility employee residential and familial information from Public Records law.
		Allow a non-resident who owns property in Ohio, their spouse and children to hunt on their land without a license if their state of residence allows Ohio residents who own land in that state to do the same.
		Create the compressed Natural Gas Study Committee to study the issue of using compressed natural gas in the vehicle fleets of the state and political subdivisions.



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	Eliminate the Treasurer of State as an office wherein a bond may be filed for the repair or removal of an abandoned service station and the restoration of property if the owner or lessee owns, leases or constructs two or more service stations in the state.
	Amend a provision in a previous operating budget regarding the exemption of public auction requirements of the sale of school district property to allow the land to be used for residential, not only commercial property as the statute stated.
	Create a certificate of conceded eminence to allow a physician who meets all of the criteria to practice medicine in a academic medical center without requiring the standard examination.
	Allow Physicians Assistants to prescribe Schedule II drugs.
	Allow the .5 Mill Maintenance Levy required by the School Facilities Commission to be used on all district building, not just those built or renovated by the SFC program.
	Extend the March 31, 2012 deadline for the Housing Study Committee Report to December 31, 2012.
	Establish minimum qualifications for individuals who serve as project managers for mass appraisals.
	Reflect compromise agreement on the composition of the new Emergency Medical Services Board.
	Require a person operating an energy facility whose operation may result in the accidental death of an animal to retain a permit from ODNR, instead of the person removing the animal.
	Modify the language relating to decision-making process for individuals with developmental disabilities.
	Direct the Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction services to create pilot project in Franklin and Scioto counties for the use of a non-addictive opiate treatment with the voluntary cooperation of individuals in the criminal justice system.
	Grant a court of appeals jurisdiction over any appeal brought by any party in relation to a ruling on a motion to modify a prior dispositional order and provides that a Public Children's Services Agency has a substantial right in protecting children in the system and achieving permanency for a child in their custody.
	Make clarifying changes to when the Department of Jobs and Family Services is required to redetermine the franchise fee for an ICF/MR that converts one or more of it's beds to provide home and community-based services.
	Require DAS to study the use of tele- and web-conferencing to reduce state travel costs and to report on it's capabilities and recommendations for improvement to the GA and Governor.
	Restore the original HB 153 appropriation for line 440-465, Federally Qualified Health Centers.
	Provide a prioritization family planning funds.
	Allow beginning drivers over 18 to receive online instruction by a program licensed by DPS in lieu of in classroom instruction.
	Permit the Registrar to create an entirely electronic remedial driving course.
	Permits a School District Board of Education to offer real property for sale to a state university whose main campus population is between 17,000 and 22,000, rather than to a community school in the districts area or public auction, if the property is within 100 feet of another university building.
	Amend the Cooperative Economic Development District statute to create a pilot program in a county with a population in the 2010 federal decennial census of between 375,000 and 400,000 to allow a municipality to use up to 5% of their water and sewer funds for debt service on economic development projects.

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	Authorize the Treasurer of State to select a designee to collect taxes levied on surplus line insurance.
	Increase to \$5000 from \$400 the maximum amount a county nursing home can hold in it's reserve fund for emergency services.
	Allow mico-markets to be exempt from licensure until the Director of the Department of Agriculture adopts rules for the licensure, temporary rules expire on June 30, 2012.
	Sunset the Digital Learning Taskforce to June 30, 2012 instead of June 30, 2013.
	Create an option for school districts and universities to provide 403b plans through the Board of Regents.
	Correct name of the 235-649 Cleveland State earmark to the "Mentoring Program of the Ohio Center for the Advancement of Women in Public Service at Cleveland State University".
	Make Department of Development FY'13 appropriations.
	Specify the Ohio State Highway Patrol has authority to enforce criminal laws in any privately run prison in this state that houses state of Ohio inmates and is being operated pursuant to ORC 9.06.
	Combine the two websites created under this bill into one site administered by the Auditor of State.
	Allow townships to exempt a property with four or more residential units from taxation if the project begins construction between April 1, 2012 and December 31, 2013 and the township tax increment financing resolution was adopted before December 14, 2001.
	Allow a township TIF issued before January 1, 2011, to use unencumbered money to pay for current public safety expenses provided that 1) the loan is repaid before the TIF expires 2) the township has entered into a hold harmless agreement with affected schools districts or a service agreement.
	Add Elections to the name of the Legislative Taskforce on Redistricting, Reapportionment and Demographic Research and upon request of the General Assembly allow them to evaluate elections bills.
	Restore HB 153 appropriation of 600-534, Adult Protective Services.
	Create the Gardening Technical Assistance Program.
	Allow the Department of Health to establish, promote and maintain a Lupus Education and Awareness Program that focus on communities at risk for contracting Lupus.
	Harmonize the amounts of the Cleveland Voucher with that of the Educational Choice Voucher.
	Repeal ORC Sections 103.144 - 103.146 which allows a committee chairman to ask LSC, with Speaker or President approval, to contract with an actuarial firm to analyze the impact of a new health insurance mandate as this authority has not been used in over 20 years.
	Repeal statutes concerning the Legislative Office of Education Oversight which was eliminated in 2005.
	Codify an existing rule that allows the Treasurer to charge for the shipping of cigarette tax stamps.
	Authorize the Tax Commissioner to accept dealer's in intangible payments directly from taxpayers, instead of Treasurer, that the commissioner not the Treasurer can bill for underpayment and provide refunds, and that taxpayers may claim a refund by asking for a final assessment instead of applying for a certificate of abatement.
