FINDING OF PROBABLE CAUSE AND DIRECTION TO EXPEDITED HEARING

Before Chair Zimpher, Vice Chair Schmidt, and Board Member Brundige: September 11, 2014.


Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 4117.12, the State Employment Relations Board (the Board) has conducted an investigation of this charge. The investigation reveals probable cause exists for believing that a violation occurred.

The Board authorizes the issuance of a complaint and refers the matter to an expedited hearing to determine if Reynoldsburg City School District Board of Education violated Ohio Revised Code § 4117.11(A)(1) but not (5) by posting details regarding bargaining proposals concerning insurance and compensation on its website during ongoing negotiations.

A complaint will be forthcoming. The hearing will be conducted within ten days of the issuance of the complaint. The Administrative Law Judge reserves the right to reschedule the hearing beyond this time with approval by the Executive Director and for good cause shown pursuant to the Board's rules.
